



COVID-19 UNWIND: Providers Asked to Help Prepare Medicaid Members for End of Public Health Emergency

January 26, 2023

Dear Providers,

The COVID-19 Public Health Emergency has been [extended](#) through April 11, 2023. The 60-day notice is expected from the U.S. Department of Health & Human Services on February 10, 2023. Eligibility renewals for Medicaid recipients (members) will be initiated in April. Providers and community partners are asked to continue outreach to members to help them prepare by following these steps:

- Update their contact information with this website: [UpdateMyAddress](#)
- Complete and return the renewal packet or request for information from the Division of Welfare and Supportive Services (DWSS). More information for members is [available here](#).
- Create and use an Access Nevada account, accessnevada.dwss.nv.gov, to receive notices/texts when a renewal is due. This tool eliminates the need to wait for the mail or be concerned about losing mail.
- [Contact their local DWSS](#) office for assistance or ask questions about any correspondence they receive.
- Sign up to receive notifications direct from Nevada Medicaid by [downloading the NV Medicaid App](#) and/or [signing up for the ListServ](#).
