Starting **January 1, 2026**, Nevada Medicaid will use one drug list called the **Single Preferred Drug List (sPDL)** for all Medicaid health plans, including SilverSummit Healthplan. The State of Nevada is making this change, so everyone has the same access to affordable medicines.

- All Medicaid health plans will use the same list of preferred medicines.
- Some of your prescriptions may need to change to match the new list (sPDL).
- There will be a 6-month transition period where you can keep getting the medicines you take now. This gives you time to talk with your doctor and switch to medicines on the new list (sPDL).
