





## What are BBSPs?

BBSPs are a new category of Qualified Health Plans (QHPs) offered through Nevada Health Link, the state's health insurance marketplace. They mirror other QHPs, providing the same essential health benefits and consumer protections under the Affordable Care Act (ACA), but are required to meet premium reduction targets to enhance affordability for Nevadans.

# When will BBSPs be available and how can consumers enroll?

Shopping begins on October 1, 2025 through NevadaHealthLink.com during the Open Enrollment "window-shopping" period. The enrollment period is from November 1, 2025 through January 15, 2026. Coverage starts on January 1, 2026. BBSPs are available statewide.



### Why is Nevada introducing BBSPs?

State legislation (SB 420, 2021) mandated BBSPs to enhance affordability, increase competition, and reduce uninsured rates among Nevadans. The federal government approved Nevada's Section 1332 waiver, enabling BBSPs from 2026 through 2030, alongside a reinsurance fund and other support measures.

#### What should providers expect?

Referrals are required to be submitted electronically through our provider portal and are required so members can see a specialist. All providers must ensure that a referral is received within the portal to ensure payment of claims. The BBSP does not permit a national network thus the network is limited only to Nevada.
