Attention Home Health and Personal Care Attendant (PCA) Providers: EVV Payor ID Changes effective 4/1

What Is Changing

Effective April 1, 2026, **EVV submissions will no longer be routed through Optum for validation.** As a result, providers must update the **Payor ID** used for EVV submissions.

Required Action

If you submit EVV through **Sandata** or an **Alternate EVV (Alt EVV) provider**, you must update your Payor ID as follows:

- **Current Payor ID:** NVSIL
- **New Payor ID:** 68069

This update must be completed in your Sandata system or with your EVV vendor to ensure EVV files are submitted and processed correctly.

Who Is Impacted

- Home Health providers
- Personal Care Attendant (PCA) providers
- Any provider submitting EVV directly or through an EVV vendor

Important Reminder

Failure to update the Payor ID by **April 1, 2026**, may result in EVV submissions not being validated or accepted.
